Even though he was extremely tired, not once did he shoo me away. Instead, he sat through the whole night patiently 'listening' to me (with his eyes closed haha), even waking up to nod his head in response every hour or so.

Our earthly fathers and father figures reflect and shape our understanding of what our Heavenly Father is like. Because my father is gentle, loving and patient, I am able to see how our God is gentle, loving and patient. Because my
