# PRE-EVENT TESTING (PET)/VACCINATED WORSHIP SERVICES: Increasing of in-person worship service cap

- Depending on the unfolding COVID situation, we aim to start our first PET/vaccinated worship services (8.45am and 11.15am) on 5th September.
- In order to attend, you will need to be vaccinated or have done a PET.
- We will also have a non-PET/vaccinated worship service (5.00pm), capped at 50pax, to cater to those who are unable to get vaccinated or do not wish to get a PET.

We strongly encourage you to register and attend this service in-person if you are able to.

Alternatively, you may also choose to continue worshipping with us online.

\*For PET status, you will need to show proof of PET taken on the day of service, either through the HealthHub app, or physical certificate of test results. Only PCR test is accepted and not more than 24 hrs before service, at your own expense.

Mt Hermon will be holding their annual Covenant Group (CG) Open Month in August. This is an event where every member who is not part of a small group gets invited to experience the life of a CG. So the CG will meet more intensively.

**Ps Luwin Wong** will be preaching 5 sermons on 2 Peter (5 Sundays in August) and, in the afternoon, the CGs will meet to do a Bible Study on the sermon passage. This year is special because the Bible Study material (5 studies) are all written by an in-house team of young adults.

- \* **Ps Luwin** will have the faith and strength to preach the Word faithfully, boldly and with integrity.
- \* The sermon and study series on 2 Peter will be transformative for the congregation so that God may be glorified in the godliness of His church.

# Let's ALL Put Our Spiritual Gifts to Use for God!

"To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good." 1 Corinthians 12:7

A spiritual gift is an empowerment from the Holy Spirit to meet the needs of people. In 1 Corinthians 12, we read of how the body is diverse with our individual unique spiritual gifts, yet we are united in the same Spirit and as one body of Christ. Knowing that all of us Christians are given a gift or gifts to use to build up the body and God's kingdom, how well are we using these gifts, especially in the context of our church?

In Timothy Keller's Ministries of Mercy, he says "Every layperson is a minister and that ministry is finding needs and meeting them with the goal of the spread of the kingdom of Christ." I cannot help but to imagine the ideal, where each Christian embraces the manifestation of the Spirit. How vibrant and purposeful would that look! Although this sounds far-reaching and unrealistic, I look around in our church, on Christian article sites like Thir.st and Salt&Light, and am so encouraged by my passionate and purpose-driven brothers and sisters who are using their gifts to magnify God's name.

I used to sit in the pews growing up looking up at all the pastors, worship and song leaders, musicians, and other people actively serving, and this subtle thought would come by saying "wow these people must be qualified and 'have what it takes' to be up there". Until I realized that, as Christians,

we are all qualified equally as children of God and we can all be useful for God! Jesus says it Himself in Matthew 11:11 "Truly, I say to you, among those born of women there has arisen no one greater than John the Baptist. Yet the one who is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he." Because of the imputed righteousness that each one of us receives in Christ through faith, we are able to be used as instruments for God with whatever gifts we have, however old we are, and whatever language we speak. There is no such thing as an extraordinary Christian or ordinary Christian. We are either Christian or not.
