

My livelihood was at stake, as the restrictions on travel and clients' "wait-and-see" attitudes amongst all the uncertainties disrupted my business activities. My children's schooling was switched to home-based learning for a couple of months in 2020. It was a struggle and challenged my patience greatly, having to juggle parental, family and work duties at the same time. Conflicts at home were inevitable, with the emotional and physical stress that everyone was bearing.

Now that we are in the later half of 2021, it has been such a blessing that as a nation, our pandemic is very much under control, and we could carry on our lives that is close to normal. Looking back to where it all started, I am thankful for all His grace, in sustaining me with strength and positivity.
