
New Covenant Bible School Course OLD TESTAMENT SURVEY

PRAYER FOR CAMBODIA

Prayer Requests by Rebecca Lee

- * Thank God for the continued progress, though slow, in developing the curriculum for missionaries to learn the Khmer language. Thank God that the new workers are motivated to learn, but hampered by lack of opportunities as Cambodians are rather cautious to be interacting with foreigners at this time. Please pray for them to stay hopeful and to reach out despite limited language and fear. Please also pray for the 4 language teachers, dealing with health problems and family issues. Pray that I may know how to support them.
- * Pray for opportunities to build a deeper relationship with my landlady, **Vanny**, 72 years old (non-Christian) and boldness to share the Gospel; pray for me to have wisdom to walk with a Christian lady, 57 years old, whose son is a drug addict finally open to kicking the habit.
- * As Cambodia battles with the Delta variant that is now everywhere, with limited expertise and resources, please pray for God to spare Cambodia from the worst. We are now approaching 100,000 cases in the space of 6 months and schools are still shut, a huge impact on family life and basic education.

Phnom Penh Bible School, Phnom Penh

- * Pray for **Sokheang** as she serves as coordinator of the Library & Literature Department as well as part-time lecturer .
- * Uphold **Vanna** who has started her final year of studies in Master of Divinity at Singapore Bible College. May the Lord grant her wisdom in her studies.

Shalom Missions Cambodia

- * Pray to the Lord to guide and help **Pastor Chhinho** to start the Shalom Dream Center situated in Mondulkiri which is about 7 hours drive from Phnom Penh.
- * The construction work of the Center is almost completed. The centre will be used as a school for children as well as a Bible School.
- * Thank God for opportunities to share the Gospel of God's love and hope to the people in this remote village.

Is your body a glorious building which brings glory to God? Or is it a shack of inferior material and workmanship? In spite of all our earthly accomplishments, the most pressing goal in our life is building up our body, which is a temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in us.

MISSIONARY REBECCA LEE

It all started with termites. No, wait, it actually started with itches and scratches all over the body, for some days. Then it twigged – my mattress probably had bed bugs (wooden bed frames and planks are the norm here). So I washed up all the sheets, gave everything within half a metre of the bed a thorough cleaning and prepared to sun the double mattress. But I just couldn't move it!

I had to get help from the landlady's odd job man. And it was then that we discovered the creatures, or rather, the evidence that they've been at work. Relieved, but anxious to get the problem sorted out, I exerted full strength to get the mattress to a better position. That was a mistake, a very bad one. You don't need the details but suffice to say that a few days later, I was desperately asking around if there was a reliable physiotherapist in town. There was! And the clinic was open, and one of 2 resident physiotherapists had a time slot for me to see her quite immediately. Thank God!

Her fingers probed ever so lightly and gently, and in cute Dutch-accented English, she would pause often to ask "Is it okay?" At certain spots, she registered the tightness of my muscles and whenever my voice pushed out an "Oomph!", her fingers would be press down slightly more firmly. Up and down, from shoulder blade to the last vertebrae of my backbone, she'd move, slow and sure. Finally, she said, "Turn over and stand up." Facing her, she shared her conclusions, "There's nothing to be greatly concerned, though" Then she showed me some exercises that I was to work on, as many times a day as possible. All very do-able, all for the layperson to practise.

After payment and getting another appointment, I went off, feeling a little sore in some spots. But my heart was not, as I felt the visit had been worthwhile; now I knew what I had to do, and there was hope for healing.

Leaving the clinic after the second visit, I was struck by a thought. Here was a professional carrying out her duties with great thoroughness, and it helped me to take her seriously. But when God probes my soul, and pauses at a place in my life

that I had not submitted to Him, what is my response? He doesn't even have to feel where the knotted areas of my life are; He knows me inside out. The problem is that I'd rather turn away from that soul examination, unlike David (Psalm 139:23). Yet He is patient and kind enough to wait, revealing those points of stubbornness and disobedience a bit at a time, gently persistent, as I am His worksmanship that He is perfecting till the day of Jesus Christ (Phil 1:6).

When was the last time that the Great Physiotherapist did some probing in your soul? How did you respond? Have you let Him deal with hidden areas such as pride, self-reliance and mixed desires? How will we respond to the exercises He prescribes – with meekness, humility and sorrow (Matthew 5:3–5)? Or gratefulness and marvel, that this grand God of the Universe is interested enough in us that He would personally stoop to correct and guide us to be more and more like Jesus (Heb 12:7)? Or joyful obedience and submission to His grace and mercy that is most evident not in material blessings but in revealing our weaknesses, sins and temptations, showing our need for Him always?

His gentleness is evident. Let Him probe and don't wait for termites to start the process.
