
New Covenant Bible School Course OLD TESTAMENT SURVEY

That's easy to Google: We find the root words \mathfrak{e} (batach) and $\mathfrak{e}\lambda\pi \mathfrak{i}\varsigma$ (elpis), meaning along the lines of "confidence, security, and being without care".

Good! Next question: What is our *hope*?

Now this question does make us burst into song – What is our hope in life and death? Christ the Lord, Christ the Lord...

We're even led to sing the next few lines – What is our only confidence? That our souls to Him belong...

Yet we might sing this with slight discomfort this week. We may have been disappointed with our current state in COVID restrictions, especially after the recent doorstop meeting announcing efforts to bring the reproduction rate and ICU numbers down, and the possibility of going back to Heightened Alert restrictions. All this after most of us got vaccinated, with the initial *hope* that restrictions will be further lifted once we hit 80%.

See how that word was used there? We may have gone through our lives **hoping** for stuff. I **hope** I get good grades for my exams. I **hope** I get that promotion. I **hope** restrictions will be lifted.

Don't mean to be an English teacher now, but these are **wishes**. There is a blurry line between the things we **hope** for, and the things we **wish** for – things which are not (fully) in our control, and yet we yearn for its fulfilment. We have been overjoyed when we see wishes fulfilled, and disappointed when they're not.

SHARING BY MANFRED

I'm sure memories of wishes are filling our heads now, the times of joy and/ or disappointment. But we can agree that these events lack that "confidence, security, and being without care".

Instead we **hope** in God. We even find this $\dot{\epsilon}\lambda\pi\dot{\epsilon}\varsigma$ hope in Hebrews 11:1 – "Now faith is being sure of what we **hope** for and certain of what we do not see." This well-known 'faith' chapter begins with this very confidence. This confidence in what God has promised in His Word, and confidence that's founded upon the Cornerstone – the One who died for us and rose again victorious.

What do we do with this faith and hope then?

Hebrews 12:1 – "Therefore... let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us."

We can run this race in this fallen world, certain of a future Kingdom where rest (and certainly COVID) is won, and with the assurance that God is before us, behind us, beneath us, and beside us.

I am by no means discounting any dread we might feel from constant restrictions. I certainly still feel this way. But my prayer for all of us is that we may place our hope in the right places. And that this hope may spur us to live our lives for Christ regardless of our situation. Whatever state we may be in, let us grow, let us be moulded, and let us not waste our lives. All due to this confidence we have in the triune God who laid our paths ahead, paid our ransom, and also showed us *hope* by example.

Hebrews 12:2 – "Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfector of our faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God."
