# **Getting Married**

This update may startle many. Maybe it is best to just say it as it is: God has brought Elder Siah Chuan and I together in a relationship. Here is how He has led us.

# I heard myself say . . .

After the Lord called me to serve Him in Japan, I prayed for a mate with whom I can serve the Lord together with. Moments of prayers yielded to years and decades of waiting. I became lax to pray. Loneliness, aloneness, illness, even kindness from well-meaning ones can trip me up. That night in the Japanese hospital, after knowing it is cancer, strangely I immediately thanked God "I was not married", because to me then, it seemed bad enough to reveal the diagnosis to my parents and siblings, what more, to a husband or children. As years passed, I imagined my medical condition 'made it harder' for God to answer prayers for marriage. Yet I knew when the time is ripe, God will bring me to the person yet also thought, "it will never happen any soon". But I resolved never to be a bitter single; tried to be content and pressed on to serve God and His people.

## I heard God say . . .

During the State of Emergency in Tokyo in April-May 2020, time alone was optimal. There was much to pray about, because my return to Singapore was near. It was then God impressed upon me, "You haven't been praying for your future husband nor marriage." That was true. So, I prayed for him – whoever he will be, and for myself to be ready. Another night, while praying, God asked, "Wan Jee, would you marry a widower?" Startled and not knowing why, I answered, "Sure Lord, that may be easier . . ."

God continued to speak. God spoke while I stood by the mirror, "Don't cut your hair, you are going to get married." I chuckled – How can it be, Lord? To whom? Forgive me Lord of my little faith. I had my hair cut. Thankfully, the hairdresser accepted the Japanese Bible prepared for him. When I sought God's will on where to go for a vacation during this pandemic, it was hard to understand why God said "Go to Melbourne". I also sensed God telling me during my prayers that He would change my life and bring about something new when I am in Singapore. I was not scared of God's voice but I was puzzled: why and what exactly do these questions/answers mean?

### I heard him say . . .

I now know why. Looking back, they were God's specific guidance to prepare me for what/who is to come. In the most unusual circumstance, God's choice for me appeared on screen, at our church's ZOOM prayer meeting. Elder Siah Chuan, then himself under lockdown in Melbourne welcomed me back to Singapore, while I served my Stay-Home-Notice (SHN) at the hotel. Conversations on-line progressed through covid issues, missions, respective personal and family situations, grief counselling, church and the world. Very soon, I heard from Siah Chuan what God had told him at that zoom prayer meeting when he saw me on screen. God revealed to him to "take care of me" . . .

As a friend, Siah Chuan knew there was a limit to how much he can care for me but would be happy to remain a friend if that was all it was meant to be. Also, if God would bring someone else into my life, he would be happy to step aside and still look out for both that person and me. Commitment, magnanimity and attraction fell into place and left me shocked, touched, amazed yet mixed with disbelief that God had handpicked Siah Chuan and said that to him concerning me.

I began to piece together the pieces and recalled those personal questions and statements God had revealed to me last year. So, it was God

pairing us, in spite of gaps in our ages, interests, inclinations, pre-dispositions, set habits and my on-going health issues. It is humbling to be the recipient of God's provision. In retrospect, God had spoken so clearly regarding a spouse-to-be: to care, to protect, to serve, to submit, and to love. Siah Chuan, while not knowing the future in full, yet very aware of my illness and its progression, responded to God's call. He respected my need and time to discern God's will and never pressurized. His proposals for a relationship, for marriage, for a life of ministry together was clear and firm. He obeyed God. What about me?

Past initial months of silent stress trying to discern God's will for both of us midst my nervy health-reports, God has given me courage to say "Yes" to Siah Chuan. Honestly, we are unable to fully comprehend and detail His every plan and will for us. Nevertheless, I pray this update and our relationship will honour God, and reflect His glory. He is the Author of our lives, who wrote the Script of our love story. 15 months into the relationship, God continues to lead us. When God wills, He will.

## **Prayer Requests:**

- Praise God for whom all blessings flow. Thank God that He always gives His best to those who leave the choice to Him, even if it means decades of waiting.
- Siah Chuan and I need faith to walk the road ahead and obey God in the joint ministries/mission field He will call us to. Please pray for God's guidance. Following the wedding, I will need to be away from the mission field for a season, and indeed have to be in Melbourne for some months.
- Pray for us to trust in God's Help as we, with our team of helpers, plan a simple wedding to be held on 30 Dec 2021, Thursday.
- Pray for Siah Chuan's eldest sister and Wan Jee's father, who are undergoing cancer treatments. Wan Jee's next medical scans are in Jan 2022.
