- \* **Mr Peter Yeo (ZMS):** Thank God for the successful procedures to clear blockage to allow normal functions of the bile duct. The biopsy results should be known soon. Pray to the Lord to guide the doctors and family members as they explore different options of treating and caring for Peter. Ask the Lord to spare him from pain and discomfort and to experience His abiding presence and peace.
