FOREIGN MISSIONS - Vietnam

Most churches have been denied registration and have faced harassment and even persecution. Pray for freedom from government repression of unregistered house churches.
- * Many Vietnamese traditionally follow Buddhism, though the veneration and worship of ancestors is an underestimated practice found throughout Vietnam. Pray for those who are persecuted because they leave their traditional lifestyle to follow Jesus.
- * According to Vietnam's Ministry of Health, as of 21 September, there had been 17, 545 coronavirus related deaths in the country. Pray for the end of the pandemic, for those whose lives and livelihood are impacted and for healthcare professionals.
