## PERSONAL NEEDS

- \* **Mrs Helen Chan (ZES)**: Thank God she is resting peacefully at home. The family has engaged day and night nurses to care for her. Continue to ask the Lord to alleviate any discomfort or pain she maybe experiencing. Praise the Lord her faith in Him is unwavering and steadfast.
- \* Remember **Joseph Ng** in prayer (son of **Philip and Nancy Ng - ZMS**): Thank God that his fever has subsided and doctors say that he is ready to head home. However, his wife, **Christina** and his daughters, **Charis** and **Kara** are down with a bad cough. The doctors have advised him to stay on in the hospital until they are well. Pray for quick recovery for all at home so that their family can be reunited. Thus far, the search for suitable bone marrow donors has yielded several overseas donors that are full matches. However, all the overseas donors have declined. **Joseph** is left with a Singaporean donor who is a close, but not full match. Pray that this will be good enough for his transplant. Pray also the Lord will keep the donor well and healthy.
- \* **Mr Peter Yeo (ZMS)**: Thank God he is discharged from hospital and staying with his daughter. The family has engaged professional caregivers to come in daily for a few hours to care for his physical needs. May the Lord grant him relief from pain and discomfort. May he find peace and comfort from the Lord.
