Dear Friends, I'm sorry for the silence. (No news is good news).

1 Chronicles 16:34

'Oh give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; for His steadfast love endures forever.'

We thank God for seeing Joseph through the 2nd round of chemotherapy with the usual horrible nausea and then an attack of fever that lasted like ten days. All the scans showed no sign of bacterial/viral/fungal infection. He is 'discharged' today and is at his in-laws' home and will return to McNair when his wife and three children recover from a bad bout of cough/flu. He is able to spend the year-end holidays with his family with occasional returns for tests/appointments. Please pray during this period he will be able to regain his strength and appetite. He lost 8 kgs.

Joseph will return to hospital on 29/30 December for the conditioning for the transplant. Meanwhile please join us together to thank God for the donor whom I named Donor Q who is a godsend. He is an altruistic Singaporean young man whose marrow is 90% match but the Lord will turn it into a miracle match. Please pray the Lord will keep him well and also for the team doing the stem cell/marrow harvest.

The conditioning for Joseph to me sounds like a third round of chemo/ radiation treatment followed by the transplant.

Thank you for praying for Joseph. Wishing you all a meaningful Christmas and blessed New Year 2022!




K-Shane...
