A Note on The Apostles' Creed

Although not written by the apostles, the Apostles' Creed is a **concise summary of their teachings**.

It originated as a baptismal confession, probably in the second century, and developed into its present form by the sixth or seventh century.

By reciting the Apostles' Creed together, we are **affirming** this summary of the teaching of Scripture and **identifying** with the faithful who have gone before.

Myanmar

- » **Pray for the Church.** Pray for God's people to experience His peace, strength and courage in the midst of political turmoil and pandemic. May the Church be a beacon of hope and continue to spread the Gospel of Jesus to those who do not know the Lord.

ZI-ON FAQs

Why are we adopting this?

COVID-19 has shown us the importance of going digital in order to facilitate our worship and fellowship. This digitalising of your personal information will allow you to view and update your details via ZI-ON, without compromising on data protection. Additional features of ZI-ON will also be rolled out gradually, and these will all be helpful in helping us minister to you better.

How will this benefit me?

In future, the updating of Holy Communion (HC) would be done via ZI-ON with just 2 clicks of a button. Members who are unable to sign up for in-person worship are also able to update their HC remotely. Also, members would be able to sign up for church events using ZI-ON. More information and details will be released in future.

I did not receive an email to activate my account, what should I do?

I am having trouble activating my account, and/or I do not own a computer or smart phone, who can help?

You may call the Church Office at 6284 1987, message 8463 2186 or approach the help desk at the Fellowship Hall on 16 & 30 January after the 8.45am Worship Service, and we will be glad to assist you. Alternatively, you may ask a family member for help.

Do I need to be a member in order to get a ZI-ON account?

ZI-ON FAQs

If I have already given my personal information to the Church and there is no change to my details, do I still need to activate my account?

To activate your account, you will only need to do a one-time set up, and we strongly encourage all members to activate their account.

How will my membership and participation in church activities be affected if I choose not to use ZI-ON for now?

Your membership will not be affected and you will still be able to participate in church activities, however we strongly encourage you to be familiar with ZI-ON should there be a need for you to use it in future.

How will digitalising my personal information benefit me?

By digitalising your information, it streamlines processes and frees up more time for our pastors, leaders and staff to focus their efforts in providing better care and support to you.

What if I have any issues assessing my ZI-ON account in the future?

You may contact the Church Office for assistance in accessing your account or updating your details.

Will the Church be able to track my movements through ZI-ON?

No, we will not be able to track your movements.
