MARRIAGE AND PARENTING MINISTRY

After our relationship with God, our marriages are the next most important relationship in life. For those of us who are married, I suspect that we find ourselves somewhere in between two extremes. On one extreme, we might not take our marriages as seriously as we should. In this sense, we are merely going through the motions of being married and slowly drifting apart. On the other extreme, we might be expecting our spouse to fulfil a deep longing in our lives.

Unfortunately, the reality of marriage leaves us disappointed and unsatisfied again and again. Taken together, how then should we think and live biblically with regard to our covenant marriages?

When we look at the Scriptures, we notice the significance of marriage. Firstly, **the Bible begins and ends with marriage** (Gen 2:24; Rev 22:20). ¹Secondly, the Bible often **uses marriage as a metaphor**. For instance, the New Testament compares the arrival of the prophesied Messiah to a wedding. Also, the Apostle Paul describes Jesus Christ as a bridegroom and His followers as a bride (2 Cor 11:1-3). In this brief look at God's Word, we catch a sense of the importance of marriage in our Christian lives.

Yet for the married couples in Zion Serangoon, we are not immune to the challenges of living in this sinful world. Even though couples may look "normal" on Sundays, we know that marital difficulties are happening behind closed doors. That is one of the reasons why our church wants to continue to encourage and equip the marriages in our midst.

Before this can be done, we need to first know the specific marital challenges that our couples are struggling with within our church. For that, I am thankful for the couples who joined us for our sharing session recently to discuss the situation in our church! If you could not make it, fret not!
