Foreign Missions

Cambodia

- » Cambodia is one of poorer nations of world where the devastating effects of Khmer Rouge regime (1974-79) are still being felt today. Despite much redevelopment in the last 30 years, the general population, particularly in the poorer countryside, suffers from inadequate education, healthcare and basic infrastructure.
- The Church has grown significantly since the 1990s. Current estimates there are more than 250,000 believers in over
 2,700 churches. Pray for impactful ongoing evangelism accompanied by effective discipleship and leadership training.

With the handover of language facilitation to Yeojoo and the completion of the language curriculum, she need not be based in Phnom Penh. This new location will possibly be a place where she can actively support Cambodian Christians as they bring the gospel to their own people, as well as be a time when she can do some writing.
- Ask the Lord to grant her wisdom and patience to work together with the rest of the Board of SONOKO (university students outreach) as we move towards independence i.e no longer under the umbrella of OMF. This is an important step for full ownership by the Cambodians that they are the ones in the lead to reach university students. But there are many obstacles partly brought about by COVID and also the usual challenges of reaching students who never stay long in one place. Pray that the Cambodian Christian students will love their fellow students as much as the Lord HImself.
