III. Conclusion - God is Willing



Sin has a contagion effect. It spreads and spirals out of control if we don't deal with it decisively and quickly. While the LORD may sometimes discipline us when we choose to stubbornly and persistently sin, the Biblical account also gives us the reassuring pattern of God's preeminent grace as he calls sinners to repentance.



Someone said, "The reading of all good books is like conversation with the finest people of current and past centuries." We may not have the opportunity to meet them, but they have given us an opportunity to reflect on their thinking. The Book Circle has a collection of books from leaders to share their thoughts, their convictions, and beliefs. Below is a write-up of one of **John MacArthur**'s books to encourage you to pick up a book to read and reflect.

The Power of Suffering - John MacArthur

For everyone who has ever faced profound trials; physical or spiritual and found ourselves asking 'Where is God in the midst of pain and suffering?' In this book, John MacArthur examines the reality of pain and trials in the Christian life and from a pastor's heart offers a plausible, biblical explanation for the deep valleys each of us inevitably cross. Hopefully, the book will not only help us better understand the unique and important role suffering plays in our lives but will equip us to cherish our trials and prepare us to comfort and encourage others.

John MacArthur is an American Protestant pastor and author known for his internationally syndicated Christian teaching radio and television program 'Grace to You'. Central to MacArthur's theology is a very high view of scriptures. He believed that scripture is inerrant and infallible because it is the 'Word of God' and God cannot lie. Furthermore, he believes that we are obliged to render full submission to scriptures above all else and that "to mishandle the Word of God is to misrepresent the One who wrote it. To reject its claims is to call Him a liar. To ignore its message is to snub that which the Holy Spirit inspire."
