

2 Timothy 2:8-12 by Elder Oswald Goh

Book Circle

As the world celebrates Earth Day on 22 April 2023; not only do we want to marvel at God's handiwork, His Creation but also worship in awe the Creator. The Bible



reminds us to "Lift up your eyes on high and see: who created these? He who brings out their host by number, calling them all by name, by the greatness of his might, and because he is strong in power, not one is missing." Isaiah 40:26. "For what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them. For His invisible attributes, namely His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made" Romans 1:19-20.

What can we glean from Christian writers about God's attributes and His Creation? The Book Circle has several books from different writers. **Joan Andre Moore** in her book, **Astronomy in the Bible**, draws the significance of God's Creation and 'His-Story" throughout the Bible as His tools for us to discover and know more of Him, and have a better understanding of Him.

Dr Henry M Morris in his book, *Exploring the Evidence for Creation*, presents evidence about creation and its Creator, about Science and the Scriptures. It cuts through the arguments and lay out the "creationist worldview" that is rational, scientific, and biblically based to help us cut through the "worldviews" generated from the theory of evolution to discover the Truth, know God, and honor Him as the Creator. Other books written by him available in the Book Circle are "5 Reasons to Believe in Recent Creation", and "Some Call It Science, the Religion of Evolution".

66TH ANNUAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING

Last week, on 16 April 2023, we got together as a Zion-Serangoon family and held our Annual Congregational Meeting (ACM). It was our 66th ACM and I deeply thank God for blessing and leading us through a fruitful, honest and meaningful meeting.

As a church and a people of God redeemed in Christ, ACMs aren't just (and shouldn't just be) normal 'business' meetings that many of us may be accustomed to in corporate parlance and practice. Church ACMs should rightfully be marked by love, unity, and a common desire to build God's Kingdom. Words spoken at a church ACM should be spoken in gentleness and grace (Colossians 4:6), and with the right motives. That was what I personally witnessed at our ACM, and I thank God for answered prayer.

Much Kingdom-work lies ahead of us. We want to be a church that "Loves beyond Boundaries". We want, with God's help, in the coming years, to become a missional church where Every Gardener is a Missionary, regardless of what season in life we currently find ourselves in. To do that, we will need to pray. We will need to be challenged by the Scope, Work and Heart of our King Jesus and His Kingdom (Matthew 9:35-38). And we will need to work, not out of compulsion or guilt, but out of sheer joy and freedom from being released from the chains of sin and death in Christ Jesus (1 Corinthians 15:58)!

Our leaders are convinced that the Christian preschool is one of the keys that the LORD has given us to open the doors of our church and the Gospel to those who still stand outside the Kingdom. Pray with us. Pray for us. Pray for yourselves. Pray that the LORD will move hearts to serve in all the ministries in our church where hands and feet are lacking. Pray that the LORD will continue to add His bountiful blessings upon Zion Serangoon as we continue discerning and moving towards becoming a Tavistock-ready church and community. Pray constantly and without ceasing (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18)!
