


BOOK CIRCLE REVIEW



The Holy Spirit by Sinclair Ferguson

(Extract of review by Lau Wah Ming on 28 May 2023)

In the book "The Holy Spirit" (in the Contours of Christian Theology series), author Sinclair Ferguson explains in great detail: What or rather Who is the Holy Spirit, Where does he come from? What is his role? Why is he important to us individually and to the church? and How must we respond? His approach is a systematic study, as he traces the revelation of the Holy Spirit from the perspective of Bible-centred theology and the history of redemption. It gets rather technical but is worth the effort of reading it.



Below is a summary of the key conclusions:

The Holy Spirit is the third Person of the Trinity. **Ferguson** traces the Spirit's activities from Genesis 1:2 through the Old Testament and shows how the Spirit has been with Jesus from the beginning, and with the people of Israel in the wilderness (Isaiah 63:10-11). **Ferguson** illustrates with many biblical texts that the Holy Spirit had a role to bear witness that Jesus was the Son of God. The Holy Spirit was revealed in the Old Testament but not fully. The Holy Spirit is fully revealed to us, Christians, only **in and through** Jesus Christ. The Spirit was the constant companion of the Son (Romans 8:9-19). The Holy Spirit's central function in the life of the Christian believer is to reshape us to be like Christ, from one degree of glory to another (See 2 Cor 3:17-18).

Why then the events at Pentecost? **Ferguson** reviews various perspectives and concludes that the Pentecost is a historical event that will not be repeated, but it is a necessary part of the redemptive work of Jesus, and a continuing task to bring born-again Christians to glory. The Spirit's coming inaugurates a communion with Christ in which the Spirit who dwelt on Christ, now dwells on and in each believer, you and me (1 Cor 15:45). Having the Spirit in us is the equivalent of having Christ indwelling in us; we are united with Christ just as Christ is united to God the Father. It is this Holy Spirit that gives us, each believer, the resource to attain holiness, little by little, even though we are humans.

Perfection will only come at glorification when we see Christ face to face. We are therefore a work-in-progress, to use modern terminology, as we are being transformed by the sanctification process in this life. In Phil 1:6, Paul in effect tells us: **Perfection "Is Coming"** at the eschaton, the final event in God's plan.

If you are sufficiently challenged by now, do invest time in reading Ferguson.

What will your response be?
