
BOOK CIRCLE WRITE-UP



MORE THAN A CARPENTER?

Sceptic Josh McDowell once thought Christians were out of their minds. He ridiculed and insulted them, then decided to combat them with his own thorough research to disapprove of the claims of Jesus Christ. To his surprise, he discovered that the evidence suggested exactly the opposite – that Jesus, instead of being simply, a first-century Hebrew carpenter, truly was God He claim to be.
