



PASTORAL UPDATES

FURTHER ACADEMIC & THEOLOGICAL TRAINING

Since January 2016, prior to joining the church as a pastoral staff in January 2017, I've had the wonderful blessing of undergoing online theological training at Covenant Theological Seminary, located in St Louis, Missouri. In the years since then, I've undergone two taught post-graduate degrees (Master of Arts in Theological Studies & Master of Arts in Biblical and Theological Studies, Hebrew focus). Throughout this time, the LORD has given me the discipline and love for ongoing theological training despite the often-difficult task of having to balance work and studies.

For most of 2022 and 2023, I prayed for the LORD's directing as I sought to continue pursuing post-graduate academic training. I prayed specifically for three things. First, for an area of Biblical research that would also be highly practical in ministry, especially in supporting Biblical historicity. Second, for a good supervisor to journey with me through the next lap of studies. And third, for unfettered and unanimous support from our Church Session.

After enquiring at a myriad of universities and seminaries, the LORD began to grant clarity by leading me to Edinburgh Theological Seminary, Scotland. After making applications, I was formally accepted into the Master of Theology (MTh) research program in December 2023. My course starts on 22 January 2024 and I'll researching ancient Egyptian cosmology (creation accounts) and the place and purpose of Genesis 1-2 in the pagan, polytheistic, ancient Near-Eastern world. God-willing, I'll be able to use this research thesis as a platform to advance into PhD research sometime in the future, as God wills.

Given my ministry commitments, I'm mindful that I may not have sufficient time to read, research, and write. However, I know that because the LORD has clearly led me to this, He will likewise supply all my needs and grant wisdom to carefully order each of my days (*Philippians 4:19; Matthew 6:33*). During this next lap of academic and theological training, I hope to also further enhance my ability to handle God's WORD so I can teach and preach more effectively. **Do keep me in your prayers.**

"I give thanks to my God for every remembrance of you, always praying with joy for all of you in my every prayer." (Philippians 1:3-4)
