


A short synopsis of the books available from these authors in our Book Circle are given below:


### **BOOK CIRCLE: RELATIONSHIPS**



A Young Woman's Guide to Making Right Choices by Elizabeth George. The author takes teens through step-by-step process of making decisions

that are life-affirming, godly and wise in areas that include choices about attitudes, behaviors, friends, clothes, finances, and college. Teens will consider checkpoints to use as guides for making decisions, and learn to take the long view when considering consequences. Young women will also realise the tremendous wisdom, guidance and answers available in God's Word. A good resource for individual, small groups, and mentoring.







Like Dew Your Youth by Eugene H Peterson emphasizes that adolescence is "God's gift", designed by the Creator to bring children to adulthood. In 'like Dew Your Youth", Peterson shows how adolescence is a time for parents to enjoy a deeper, richer relationships with Christ. In addition to its wealth of positive, effective ways to deal with many of the problems and pains of growing up, this book offers an understanding of parent-adolescent relationships that will help promote an atmosphere of communication, growth, frankness, forgiveness, love, and harmony in the home.

God speaks to Women Today by Eugenia Price shares inspirational advice for women on how to follow the Bible and its practical and insightful guidelines to finding the secrets of living a happy, productive, and fulfilling life.

**Weird by Craig Groeschel** unpacks a Christ-centred philosophy that help you to:

- Use your time wisely.
- · Put money in a godly perspective.
- Have healthy relationships.
- Understand sex as God intended it.
- Center our values around Jesus.

More Than Me by Jim Paterson/ Glenn McMahan/David Russ focus on four principles that make all relationships succeed: integrity, love, humility, and forgiveness; all values essential to the most intimate and the most public relationships, yet we cannot achieve them on our own. The authors explain how we can be empowered by God to practice these for four compelling keys to relational wholeness.



The Revolution of Love by George Verwer, former International Coordinator of Operation Mobilisation, points men, and women to the central theme of the Christian life; Spiritual balance, The Holy Spirit, The Lordship of Christ, and World Mission.

Love Life by Ed Wheat helps you improve your marriage, through sharing, touching, appreciating, focusing healing attention on your mate, answering physical, psychological, and stress-related questions in a Christian context.



Friends & Friendship by Jerry and Mary White helps on how to make friends, how to keep the ones you have, and when you're justified in backing off from making new friends. "God knows your needs. He wants to give you close friends." The authors points to the biblical cure for loneliness.
