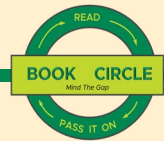

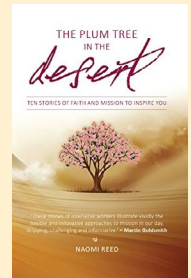


Below are synopses of various books written by Christian authors on Mission. These books are available in the Book Circle under the category of Mission

The Plum Tree in the Desert by Naomi Reed

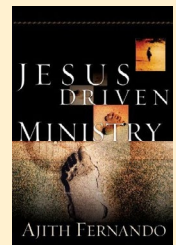

In “The Plum in the Desert”, Naomi Reed tells stories of difficult situations in the mission field; some of victory, some which left mission workers feeling that they had failed. But despite the difficulties and perceived failures, each story speaks of the goodness of God and what it means to persevere and trust in Him, even when it seems too hard. These stories give us a new perspective on those perceived failures and remind us that “in all things God works for the good of those who love him”



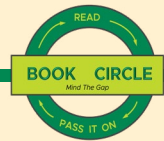
Jesus Driven Ministry by Fernando, Ajith

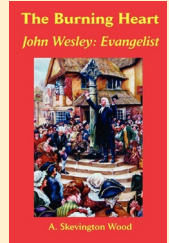

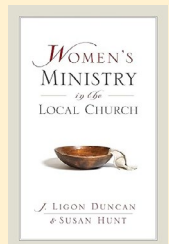
Living Without Regrets by Theodore Williams

This book has practical, biblical answers to encourage a lifestyle of faith, sacrifice and commitment; a book related to Biblical answer to faith and commitment.

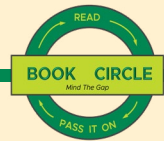
Women's Ministry in the Local Church by J Ligon Duncan & Susan Hunt

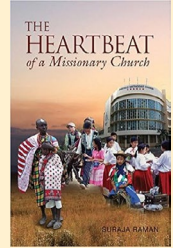


BOOK CIRCLE: MISSIONS (PART 2)
