

CEBU MISSION TRIP REFLECTIONS

We thank God for the opportunity to minister to Grace Evangelical Gospel Church (GEGC) in Cebu, Philippines, from 6 to 12 July 2024. Below are the reflections from the team members of the Cebu Mission Trip.

Esther Ng (Ministry Intern)

From 6 to 12 July 2024, Pastor Wendell, April, Peiyi and myself went to Cebu, Philippines, to equip and train our Mission Partners in GEGC. I thank God for this time to reconnect with, and mutually encourage our GEGC friends. During the reflection sessions in Cebu, I remember a



15-year-old teen who shared with us about the cost of following Christ. She shared about the parental opposition she faces to join the church community, the long journey it takes to travel to church (at least 2 hours!), and the opportunity cost of spending time in church, when it could be time used to provide food for her younger siblings living in poverty.

Despite these challenges, she shared that her hope in life was to bring her parents to Christ. Many of the youth in GEGC face such challenges. Yet, they persevere and find joy in Christ despite their circumstances. I thank God for their example, and have been encouraged through their sharing, to reflect on my own faith and the cost of following Christ in my own life. I pray that the Lord will continue to ground GEGC in Him, for GEGC to persevere with joy in Christ through their trials, and for the Lord to bless the partnership between our churches, so we may support one another as a body in Christ.

April Wu-Ding (Church Staff, Church Co-ordinator)

I think what was most impactful to me during this trip was the generosity and faithfulness of GEGC. During the Sunday Worship Service, they mentioned that they did not yet have sufficient funds to purchase the materials for their upcoming Vacation Bible School (VBS). Despite the circumstances, they still trusted God's provision, as He had provided for them the past 2 VBS' in the previous weeks. That Sunday, even before hearing about this need, people generously gave out of the little they had. By God's grace, they received more than half the amount required.

CEBU MISSION TRIP REFLECTIONS

Many of these families are living in poverty and struggling to support their big families, and yet they were so generous in their giving to God. If they could give so generously to meet ~S\$500 even though it is a lot to them, how much more can we give as a church to the work of the gospel out of the much we've been blessed with!

Secondly, it was a sacrifice for church members to come to the city for our 3-day full day workshop, whether due to its distance from the more remote areas of Cebu, or the disapproval of their parents, yet they faithfully did so. Through their sharing, I came to see how even in the suffering and obstacles they face, they chose to follow Jesus and prioritize His work, and

this made them so single-minded and obedient to God's mission to reach out to non-believers. I hope that as a church, we are also challenged to have that generous and single-minded unity to live out God's mission for Zion Serangoon in the years to come!



Ng Peiyi (Church Staff, Music, Worship & AV)

This was my second time going to Cebu on missions and there was a familiarity and warmth that accompanied it. It was such a blessing to be able to spend a lot more personal time with the young adults of GEGC. From worshipping and serving together in their Sunday worship service, to the three full days of program during the week, what was clear throughout was their desire and love for Christ and to know Him deeper. And as the days went by, I can only look back and marvel at the way God used our sessions to encourage and speak to the members of GEGC. Hearing some of their stories about how they struggle with real-life persecution that they face from their workplace and families, and yet still willing to follow Jesus regardless of the cost was to me, a testimony of the transformative power of the Gospel.

Personally, I am filled with humble gratitude for how the Lord has guided and placed me in a position to be able to share my blessings and gifts with GEGC. It was a joy to share with them how music could be used as an offering in service to our God. And while our churches may be in different pockets of the world, as one body of Christ we are united in the gospel and I pray that the Lord will continue to guide our churches and use our partnership to further His Kingdom work.

CEBU MISSION TRIP REFLECTIONS

I was deeply blessed and privileged to speak at GEGC's Sunday worship service and to teach through Paul's letter to the Philippians over 3 days thereafter. There is a kind of joy that's so full and rich, yet difficult to explain, when



teaching God's Word to those who hunger and thirst for it. While many who came are visibly very poor, what we were showered with was an abundance of love and generosity. The abundance that was lavished on us from whatever little our brothers and sisters in Cebu have was deeply humbling and moving for me. I miss the smiles, laughter and the tears, and look forward to the next time we will see and fellowship with our brothers and sisters again.

Praise God for this Partnership in the Gospel! May we continue to be intentional to pray for our mission partners.
