# **SYNOPSIS OF GOSPEL TRACTS (CNY)**

## CHINESE NEW YEAR TRACT - BLESSING

Good wishes for blessings during Lunar New Year conveyed to one another lights up the atmosphere of the Lunar New Year both in verbal greetings and very often seen displayed on couplets.

Here's a gospel tract that directs our attention to Chinese character for Blessing. It gives an iconographic analysis of the word blessing. It directs our thoughts to the understanding of the original blessedness of man – he's created for blessedness as he walks in the Garden (of Eden) with God, the Divine.

It explains that this Divine design for man's blessings was lost through the man's fall and sin. Instead of blessing man is under Divine condemnation.

However, God, through the redeeming work of Christ, His only begotten son, restores to man His blessings. One that is eternal.

May we share this message as we convey blessings at Lunar New Year.
