WEEKLY PRAYER GUIDE

Prayer for the World: Europe *(Adapted from <https://lausanne.org/pray>)*

Europe - stretching from Ireland to parts of Russia, from Greenland to Greece - is seeing the long twilight of traditional Christianity. Most of the peoples of Europe were baptized by 1000AD and have had a Christian background ever since. Europe's nominal Christians are similar to soccer supporters who follow their team but never go to a match. They treat Christianity as a public utility, something you only call on in times of need. But now, even this nominal Christian identity is fading fast. In the Czech Republic, for example, over 70% of people now say they are 'non-religious.'

- » Pray for Evangelicals in European countries with a stronger Protestant heritage such as Norway, Switzerland, Germany and the Netherlands, that they may continue to be a light in the region.
- » The south-east European state of Romania also has many evangelicals. It has a large Roma population, many of whom are Pentecostals, and also an evangelical movement within the Romanian Orthodox Church. Praise the Lord!
- » Pray for the Evangelicals in Belgium, Bulgaria, France, Ireland, Italy, Lithuania, Malta, Monaco, Portugal, Slovakia and Spain. Here, evangelicals make up an active minority of around 1% and are often members of the poorest communities, or might be Roma, former drug users, or migrants.
- » Pray that the gospel will be spread across Europe where Evangelicals are a tiny minority, tens of thousands or less in each country.
- » Pray for a deep, wide renewal among the peoples of Europe, and the revival of Christian identity based on encounters with the living Christ!

Family Sunday Worship (FSW)

- » Praise the LORD that our church members and friends have been modelling well how to worship to the children who join us during FSW.
- » Ask for love, grace and strength for our parents and caregivers to raise their children in knowing and loving Jesus.
- » Ask the LORD to open our spiritual eyes to see how the Holy Spirit wants us to cultivate an intergenerational church.

WEEKLY PRAYER GUIDE

Book Circle

- » Please pray for God to use the Book Circle, a Word Ministry to minister to those who seek to enrich their lives. Pray that the collection of books will grow to meet the needs of the different generations.
- » Pray that anyone who picks up a book will be ministered to and address their needs, problems and issues as it points to God's Word and life examples of fellow Christians, today and in the past.



He tells me often that he’s praying for me and that means a lot to me. His quiet and humble demeanor also model Christ for me and I’ve been deeply blessed to have worked alongside this faithful brother-in-Christ! I’m sure many of you have likewise been blessed by Tim in many ways.
