Updates on Zion-Anglican Preschool Partnership

A couple of months back, I wrote a short update to appraise the congregation about the status of our partnership with the Anglican Preschool Services or APS. Since then, I'm heartened that some members have taken the time to meet up with me to find out more, so they can better pray over the matter. I thought it timely to provide you with a more detailed update.

As I mentioned in my previous bulletin update, the APS Board of Directors requested that a more comprehensive market research be conducted to clearly ascertain the viability of starting a preschool at Zion. This market survey was initiated in December 2024 and the final report will be released to both Zion and APS by Milieu Insight Pte Ltd, a market research firm that also conducted a similar study for the Hebron BP-APS partnership in 2024.

Why did the APS Board initiate this when advanced discussion were already going on between the Zion Session and the APS Management Team? This was because the APS Board (distinct from the Management Team) felt the need to obtain further market

figures to ensure the sustainability and longevity of a Christian preschool at Zion. This was deemed especially important since faith-based preschools operate in a very challenging preschool sector.

Through the ups and downs of our journey to restart a Christian preschool at our church, the Session has been reminded over and over that the LORD is sovereign and that He's in complete control of all that will or will not happen.

Our current church-wide study of Ezra is especially timely and instructional. Right at the very start of the book, God reminds us that He's fully in charge over all things, even over the seemingly powerful political military giants of the day. With Israel deep in exile because of their sin, Ezra tells us that God moved and did what seemed impossible: "The Lord put it into the mind of King Cyrus to issue a proclamation throughout his entire kingdom and to put it in writing. (Ezra 1:1). And what did the LORD put in the king's mind to do? To release Israel from exile and captivity so they could return to the Promised Land.

Updates on Zion-Anglican Preschool Partnership (Cont)

The Bible consistently reminds us that *there's nothing the LORD cannot do*. If it's His will, it will come to pass. This is the same confidence I have in the LORD has He continues to show us His will for the preschool partnership.

Will you please pray with the Session and Board of Deacons over this matter?

Pray that the LORD will guide the market researchers as they conduct their work and that their final report will give us clarity into the LORD's will for this matter.

Pray that the LORD will grant favour to the Christian preschool sector so that many little ones will be exposed to Christ and His Gospel from a very early age. May this important work not be extinguished.
