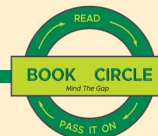

Introducing C.S. Lewis - available in audio & e-books

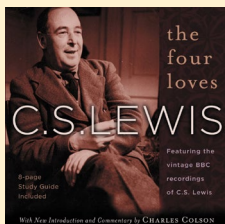

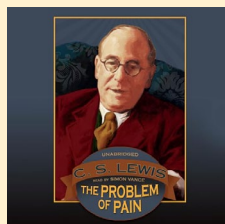

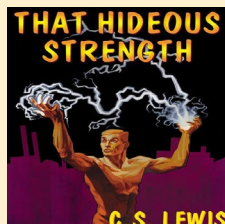

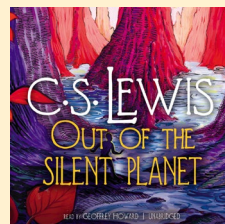
▲ The Four Loves

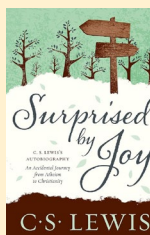
