- 1. Barriers to Mercy: What social, racial, or religious barriers might you be unintentionally erecting that could limit God's mercy from reaching others? How can you intentionally break down these barriers to reflect God's heart for all people?
- 2. Faith in the Face of Rejection: The Syrophoenician woman faced rejection and dismissal, yet she persisted in her faith. What challenges or rejections have you faced in your own life or faith journey? How can you draw inspiration from this woman's example to persevere in faith?

WEEKLY PRAYER GUIDE

Praying for the World: Iraq (Adapted from www.lausanne.org/pray)

- » Pray for leaders for the churches. Some male leaders have been killed, targeted by Islamists. Many times their widows have continued with the pastoral and discipleship work.

- » Iraq has suffered years of war, invasion, corruption and violence. Iraqis have seen the destruction of the basic infrastructure that underpins civilisation. 'Liberation' has not liberated them. Pray for the healing of the nation.

10 Christian Books that influenced my Spiritual Walk

Testimony by Dr. Lee Soon Tai

The following books played a great part in my spiritual walk. I started going to Church at 9 years old, started reading Christian books by 15 years old, with serious reflective reading at around 18 years old. I have moved from physical books to F-books for more than two decades.

For core doctrinal foundations, I found "Mere Christianity" and "Knowing God" the two most essential books. During the days in the university, with a small group of university-mates in the Varsity Christian Fellowship, we went through these two books. I did the same with my Church mates too. These books were repeated with my family when the children were married. These two books teach well what it means to be a Christian and to appreciate the manifold attributes of God.


At the end of my second year in the University, before we started Clinical medicine, as a discussion leader, I went through "Spiritual Depression" in a VCF Medical Camp. We discussed its Causes and Cure, as suggested by Dr Martin Lloyd-Jones.


"The Gospel According to Jesus" by John MacArthur, clarified and solidified my understanding of what matters most in evangelism. I am in the process of preparing a longer write up for the reading club of our Church. James Houston from Regent College expanded my understanding of how prayer begins to change my life and then how the way I live changes, and how I pray in his easily readable book, "The Transforming Friendship".





"Flame for God: John Sung and Revival in the Far East" was one exciting historical book I read very early in the church life because of the massive impact of John Sung in the history of development of the Bible-Presbyterian Church in Singapore. Leslie Lyall, the author, was an Overseas Missionary Fellowship missionary who had spent much time in China.

I love fiction and there are two which I strongly recommend. One is relatively modern, "In His Steps" by Charles Sheldon, a Christian novel first published in 1896, explores the concept of living one's life by asking "What would Jesus do?" Another, more ancient but classic fiction is John Bunyan's "Pilgrim's Progress". In 1678.

John Bunyan was a writer without going through any formal education. The only book that he read, studied, memorized and dreamt was the Bible.


Last, but not the least, is "Why Revival Tarries" by the intense, critical yet so prophetically true to what is plaguing the modern Church leadership today. Without mincing words, you feel the emotions of this fast-paced short book by Leonard Ravenhill.




