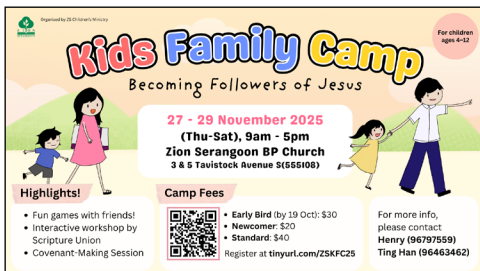

Community Haircut Event at Ang Mo Kio

All Glory to God! “Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift” and “May all glory be to Him”—indeed, we have every reason to give thanks and praise, for our God is faithful and hears our prayers.

In March–April this year, the Lord wonderfully placed in our hearts the vision to organize a charity haircut for the community. Initially, we connected with a team of hairstylists, but after the event date was confirmed with Ang Mo Kio Town Council, they realized they were already committed to serving at a nursing home in Malaysia on the same day. Yet by God’s gracious arrangement, we were introduced to the MDI hairstylist team, who, upon hearing the plan, willingly and wholeheartedly agreed to support it. Truly, thanks be to God!



On 16 August 2025, the charity haircut event took place. Although the programme was set to begin at 10 a.m., residents started arriving as early as 9 a.m. After registration, they patiently waited for their turn. Seeing many elderly friends already present, the hairstylists gladly began half an hour earlier. By God’s grace, about 70 residents—men, women, young and old—received haircuts that day. Many expressed their joy and satisfaction, and even asked when the next session would be.

Through this event, we especially give thanks to God for:

- » Moving 9 professional hairstylists to volunteer their time and skills.
- » Stirring the hearts of many church coworkers who labored in preparation during the 2–3 months leading up to the event, and who served faithfully on the day itself.
- » Touching the hearts of residents from Blocks 123, 125, 121, and the surrounding areas to come and participate.
- » Granting the full support of Ang Mo Kio Town Council, Residents’ Committee, and other departments, who graciously waived venue rental, utilities, and cleaning fees for the church.
