### **COVENANT FAMILY MINISTRY (CFM)**

In March 2025, the Family Ministry was renamed Covenant Family Ministry (CFM). After much thought and prayer, the Session discerned there was a pressing need to help our families at Zion recapture and live out the important principles of covenant-family life. But what exactly is a covenant family and what does it mean to live in a covenant family?

In a nutshell, the covenant family is the household shaped by God's covenant of grace. The covenant family is one in which the father, who is the head, and the mother are both Christians, and are directing, training, and modelling for their children in spiritual matters concerning Christ and His Gospel.

Job, for example, was the head of his family and made sacrifices even for his adult children. Job exercised his right and the authority as a Godly father to act on behalf of his children. We read in Job 1:5: "Whenever a round of banqueting was over, Job would send for his children and purify them, rising early in the morning to offer burnt offerings for all of them. For Job thought: Perhaps my children have sinned, having cursed God in their hearts. This was Job's regular practice."

Another notable example where God worked through the covenant household is Noah. We know that Noah and his family were delivered from the flood because of Noah's faith. Noah acted as a representative for his whole family. Genesis 7:1: "Then the Lord said to Noah, "Enter the ark, you and all your household, for I have seen that you alone are righteous before Me in this generation."

The Apostle Paul clearly understood the significance of the covenant family. He taught that children of believers (even Gentiles) were under God's covenant and potential heirs to the covenant if they too would believe in Christ. Paul writes in 1 Corinthians 7:14: "For the unbelieving husband is set apart for God by the wife, and the unbelieving wife is set apart for God by the husband. Otherwise your children would be corrupt, but now they are set apart for God."

I want to be clear that children certainly don't inherit salvation. This is something they need to personally appropriate by faith at some point in their lives (Ephesians 2:8-9; Romans 3:28; Galatians 2:16). However, children of a believing parent or believing parents inherit the promises of God.



### **COVENANT FAMILY MINISTRY (CFM)**

They inherit the assurance that God's favour is directed towards them because they are children of believers. They inherit the fellowship and protection of the church. They inherit the privilege of sitting under the Gospel and understanding who Christ is and what He came to do. Yet, they are also put under great obligation to come to Christ in an act of personal faith at some point in their lives.

Parents who believe this baptise their children and promise, before God and the congregation, to teach, instruct, and model Christ to their children.

To summarize, the key principles of the covenant family are:

- 1. God's covenant includes families God's promise is to believers and their children (Genesis 17:7).
  - "I will keep My covenant between Me and you, and your future offspring throughout their generations, as an everlasting covenant to be your God and the God of your offspring after you."
- 2. Our children are included in the covenant The promise is for you and your children (Acts 2:39).
  - "For the promise is for you and for your children, and for all who are far off, as many as the Lord our God will call."
- 3. Parents have great responsibility Parents must bring children up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord (Ephesians 6:4).
  - "Fathers, don't stir up anger in your children, but bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord."
- 4. Remember family worship & catechism Teach God's Word diligently to your children (Deuteronomy 6:6–7).
  - "These words that I am giving you today are to be in your heart. Repeat them to your children. Talk about them when you sit in your house and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up."

5. The role of the Church – Children are part of the body of Christ (Mark 10:14).

"Let the little children come to Me. Don't stop them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these."

6. The impact of generational continuity – God's steadfast love is for those who fear Him "to children's children" (Psalm 103:17-18).

"But the steadfast love of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting on those who fear him, and his righteousness to children's children, to those who keep his covenant and remember to do his commandments."

Going forward, the CFC emphasize the importance of covenant families as part of Zion's direction towards deeper personal discipleship. Christian discipleship starts in the home, and it stems from Godly fathers and mothers who model Christ and disciple them in Christlikeness. This is one of the reasons why the CFC has partnered with the Children's Ministry to plan this year's **Kid's Family Camp (KFC) from 27-29 November**. We encourage all parents to set aside these dates, especially the Saturday morning of 29 November to join your children in learning about covenant-making and Godly disciplines in your families. We truly look forward to seeing entire families attending KFC together!
