

BLK 123 MINISTRY UPDATES

"Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift." — 2 Corinthians 9:15

It has been six months since sister Yee Ling and I took up the ministry work at Ang Mo Kio Block 123, and we want to give thanks to God for His unfailing grace and provision. Throughout this period, from reaching out to residents to organizing community activities, we have continually witnessed His faithful hand guiding and sustaining us. Truly, all glory belongs to God!

A New Breakthrough

We are grateful to share a small but meaningful breakthrough in this ministry. Beginning in October, we have started a seeker's Bible study held in the homes of residents who are keen to learn more about the Christian faith.

At present, five residents have expressed interest in understanding our faith more deeply. Due to different schedules, most of them attend separate sessions. Though modest in number, we see God's hand at work in each encounter.

Each Bible study session is intentionally simple and personal. We begin with prayers, followed by Bible reading and a time of sharing and singing, and conclude with benediction. Light refreshments are served afterward, allowing for warm fellowship and further conversations. The session typically lasts about one to one and a half hours, and we meet once a week.



We are encouraged by the openness of these residents and the trust that is being built. It is our prayer that through these weekly gatherings, they will come to understand the message of salvation, experience God's love, and, in His time, choose to follow Christ and be baptized into His church.

Please keep us in prayer:

- 1. For the ministry team Pray that the co-workers serving at Blk 123 will continue to work in unity, each fulfilling their God-given roles with faithfulness. Ask the Lord to grant us wisdom in planning, discernment in conversations, and compassion in every visit and Bible study.
- 2. For the residents attending the Bible study Pray that as they study God's Word, their hearts will be opened to know Jesus personally and to grasp the depth of His love and truth.
