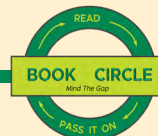


The Reformation did not happen instantaneously; it was something God patiently arranged over several years through many people. In the **“Reformation Heroes, Vol 1 & 2”**, you will learn how God used some people to plant the seeds of reform long before October 31, 1517, when Martin Luther published his 95 theses. You will find it interesting and instructive to read about him and forty others (Philip Melancthon, Huldrych Zwingli, John Knox, John Calvin and many more).

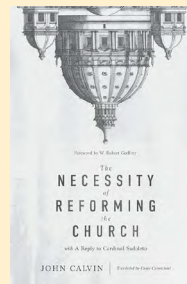
Brian Johnston explains in **“The Five Sacred Solos”**, the 5 great truths or teachings that stand alone: its significance and relevance even in today’s times.



“The Five Points of Calvinism” introduces the essential tenets of Calvinist Theology: its history and content; a biblical defense and a guide to further study.



In this new translation “***The Necessity of Reforming the Church***”, Dr Casey Carmichael re-counted that the church reached a turning point in the sixteenth century. Worship had become a spectacle, the gospel was distorted, the sacraments were replaced by superstition and ministers lived in immorality. To restore the church to the teachings of Christ and return to God’s authoritative Word, John Calvin presents four areas of church’s life and doctrine that must be carefully guarded and guided by Scripture. This timeless call for biblical faithfulness beckons us today. How will we respond?
