SERMON NOTES

Faithful Faith that Pleases God

Mark 11:12-25



The withered fig tree (Israel's fruitlessness) warns us that God desires real fruit, not empty show. The cleansed temple reminds us to guard God's house from corruption. True worship bears fruit (fig tree), honors God's house (temple), trusts in prayer (mountain-moving faith) and forgives others (God forgave us in Christ)

In Mark 11:12–25, Jesus teaches us important lessons about faith, worship, and the attitude of our hearts in three key points:

1. How Jesus Looks at Fruitless Faith (vv. 12–14, 20–21)
2. Leadership and Congregational Responsibility (vv. 15–19)
3. What Faith, Prayer and Forgiveness Bring (vv. 22–25)

Reflections...

Jesus calls us to examine our lives: Are we fruitful? Are we guarding God's house together? Are we praying with faith and forgiveness?

WEEKLY PRAYER GUIDE

Praying for fellow BPCIS Churches: Mt Gerizim B-P Church

WEEKLY PRAYER GUIDE

Reformation Week (Adapted from The Gospel Coalition)

- » Thank God for Sola scriptura: “Scripture alone” – without the inspired, inerrant, infallible, all-sufficient Word of God we would be lost in a maze of the traditions and schemes of men.
- » Thank God for Sola fide: “faith alone” – that wonderful gift granted to us through no merit of our own.
- » Let us rejoice that Sola fide is closely knit to Sola gratia: “grace alone” the banner that was raised high destroying the damnable doctrine of salvation by works by which no one could ever hope to be saved. For by grace we are saved through faith and not of works, but by that glorious free gift of God. Thank our LORD God for delivering us from legalism.
- » Let us ponder that great reformation cry Solus Christus: “Christ alone” – the Lamb of God that bore the wrath of God for undeserving sinners condemned by God. We are humbled today that in Christ alone we have been given a righteousness that is not our own.
- » Lastly, together we cry with our fellow reformers, Soli Deo gloria: “to the glory of God alone.” Not to us, O LORD, not to us, but to God’s name we give glory, for the sake of His steadfast love and His faithfulness! (Psa 115:1)



Cambodia Mission Trip Reflections by Sylvia Ong

I really thank God for an opportunity to follow the team for mission trip to Cambodia. This is my first mission trip.
