Praying for the World: SRI LANKA

This beautiful tropical country of 21 million people in South Asia is home to majority Sinhalese and minority Tamil communities. The Christian community is about 8% of the population, mostly Catholic, and declining. More than 250 people were killed by Islamic suicide bombers who targeted Catholic churches and hotels in 2019. The churches have also suffered at the hands of Buddhist extremists in the past few years. Evangelicals are growing.

- » Thank God for the nation of Sri Lanka, its rich religious diversity, and the unity it aspires to and strives to have in and through its diversity, even when it is never perfect.
- » Pray for a return to the tolerance and non-violence.
- » Pray that the Church will lead the way in peace-making and forgiveness and grow numerically and in unity and maturity.

LETTER FROM THE SESSION



Zion Serangoon-Anglican Preschool Services Partnership Update

"Many are the plans in a person's heart, but it is the Lord's purpose that prevails." (Proverbs 19:21)

On 24 October 2025, we received word from Anglican Preschool Services (APS) that they will not be proceeding with plans to start a Christian preschool at our premises. This marks the conclusion of nearly two years of prayerful discussion and discernment between Zion Serangoon (ZS) and APS.

APS has shared that the environment for Christian preschools in Singapore remains challenging, and they have chosen to focus their efforts on strengthening their existing schools. We thank God for giving clarity and closure in this matter.

While the APS preschool will not be moving forward, our calling as a church remains unchanged. The Lord continues to prepare us to be "Tavistock-ready"—where every gardener is a missionary. With the new MRT station opening soon, we are still being positioned by God to reach our neighbourhood with the Gospel.

Let us therefore pray and seek the Lord together:

Should Zion continue being involved in early childhood preschool Christian education and discern another Christian partner?

If not, how might we continue growing toward this vision even without a preschool?

How can each ministry use our space and resources more fruitfully for the Kingdom?

How can we more intentionally and passionately share Christ with our friends, neighbours, and community?

Scripture reminds us that "Unless the Lord builds the house, those who build it labour in vain." (Psalm 127:1)

Over the past year, the Lord has brought various community partners to our doorstep. Let us pray for wisdom to work alongside them for the sake of the Gospel.

We invite the congregation to pray with the Session – for patience, for clarity, and for renewed burden for those still outside the Kingdom of God, especially within our Tavistock community. We trust that the Lord will continue guiding us step by step as we labour in the work of the Gospel.

Let us pray together, as one church in Christ: "Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven." (Matthew 6:10)

May the Lord lead us forward in His time and may all that we do be for His Kingdom and glory.

We aren't meant to wait for holiness - we're meant to pursue it. God commands Christians to actively "be holy," but what does that look like in daily life? Rather than overwhelming legalism or loose boundaries, Don Whitney in his book, Spiritual Disciplines for Christian Life encourages us to find a practical middle ground through biblical habits of Worship, His Word, Service, Prayer, Fellowship and many more.... Below are books on Service, Prayer and Fellowship for our discipleship journey to be like Christ.

BOOKS ON SERVICE



In *Halftime*, *Buford* provides the encouragement and insight to propel your life on a new course to true significance - and the best years of your life. Buford focuses on this important time of transition to the second half of your life, leading you to: take stock of your successes and accomplishments thus far, redefine significance and what it means to you, identify your personal goals, develop a mission for serving God in the second half of your life and more.

Serving Without Sinking by John Hindley challenges our motivations for serving and to have a right view of God, ourselves and others we serve, and the importance of prayer as we serve. It honours Christ by focusing on Him, rather than us. Hindley reminds us that if we're serving Jesus to be good enough for Him, or to get something from Him, or to repay Jesus in some way, then we have forgotten the heart of the good news. Jesus came to serve us, as stated in Mark 10:45. This is His free gift to us. We don't have to measure up, earn our way, or repay the debt. Serving is not jobs that have to be done, but gifts to be unwrapped. These gifts are not for our sake, but gifts to be enjoyed by the church body.


BOOKS ON FELLOWSHIP



Being the Body by Charles Colson and Ellen Vaughn calls Christians to live out their faith by being a light in the world. It explores how Christians can move beyond a purely individualistic faith to embody the communal vision of the church through engaging with contemporary culture and global issues. Before all of us, daily, are the realities of life and death, terror and hope, light and darkness, brokenness and healing. We cannot withdraw to the comfort of our sanctuaries...we must engage with one another in the body of Christ. Being the Body

inspires us to rise above a stunted "Jesus and me" faith to a nobler view of something bigger and grander than ourselves--the glorious, holy vision for which God created the church.

How do Christ's followers reach across the dividing lines of our culture to offer hospitality and hope? How do local congregations worship God faithfully on Sunday and bear witness to their neighbours with fitting words and deeds during the week? *The Drama of Discipleship* is a resource for being and making disciples of Jesus in the everyday tasks of being human. Each episode offers at least one group activity that is designed to catalyse group action on your local stage and build your congregation's practice of taking off the old ways of being human and putting on the true image of God—Christ. *The Drama*



concludes with additional tools for those who lead small groups in the heart work of discipleship, as well as a neighbourhood survey for those who lead congregations in the fieldwork of discipling the nations.

BOOKS ON PRAYER



"Prayer is a matter of theology and ethics, both thinking and doing" writes James Houston. "It is guided by what we believe and how we believe." How we pray is deeply determined by how we perceive God. But no matter how we see God, prayer is something that seems to come only with difficulty. We tend to view prayer as a rigorous discipline or a required spiritual exercise. Houston wants us to see that prayer ius simply keeping company with God. "The Transforming Power of Prayer" closely examines the true nature of prayer and helps

us view prayer not as a dreary exercise or a skill to be mastered, but as a valuable chance to deepen our friendship with God and be transformed in the process.




BOOKS ON PRAYER



Your Kingdom Come... The next great move of God will come as a result of Prayer & Obedience by the body of Christ. Discover how God made us partners with Him for the fulfilment of His purpose on earth. In Daniel Kolenda's book, Your Kingdom Come, you will learn that Prayer that Open Doors; Prayer that Delivers; Prayer that Brings Heaven to Earth; Prayer that Releases the Miraculous; and Praying with Expectancy Prayer.

How to Pray with Power and Passion according to Tommy Tenney, focus on heartfelt desire and desperation for God, not just formal or intellectual prayer. His teachings suggest embracing a passionate, intimate conversation with God through different types of prayer, such as intercession and surrender, believing that heartfelt prayers are more impactful that those merely professional or routine. Cultivating a strong prayer life involves making it a passionate, dedicated and transformative part of your relationship with God. This gathering of biblical, historical, and contemporary prayers inspires and leads the reader into life-changing and purposeful communication with God.
