## PARTNERSHIP WITH GRACE BP CHURCH

As part of the Bible-Presbyterian Church in Singapore (BPCIS), Zion Serangoon belongs to a family of 11 sister churches. In recent years, BPCIS has encouraged stronger congregations to support those in transition—like Zion Bishan helping Emmanuel, and Mount Hermon partnering Mount Horeb. These collaborations have brought renewal and revitalization to the churches involved.

In September 2024, Grace B-P Church reached out to our Session after the retirement of their long-serving pastor, Rev. Dr. Tan Eng Boo. They asked if we could assist them with pastoral leadership while preparing for their next pastor. After almost a year of prayerful consideration, our Session sensed the Lord's leading to partner with Grace BPC for the sake of the Gospel and the strengthening of His Church.

Here's what this partnership involves (commencing 1 January 2026):

- Pastor Joseph Tee will serve part-time at Grace BPC as their Interim Pastor while continuing his ministry with us. We thank God for his willingness and joy in doing so.
- » Pastor Wendell Chua will mentor Pastor Zhang Li Feng who was recently ordained as a Minister of the Gospel
- » Elder Oswald Goh will mentor deacons for eldership.
- » Representatives of both Sessions will meet quarterly to pray, review, and strengthen this partnership.
- » Our preaching team will also support Grace BPC's pulpit ministry in 2026.

We hope, by God's grace, that this partnership will bring about renewal at Grace BPC with the Holy Spirit's help, just as the Lord has done through other BPCIS collaborations. The Apostle Paul exhorts us like this: "Therefore, as we have opportunity, we must work for the good of all, especially for those who belong to the household of faith." (Galatians 6:10)
