WEEKLY PRAYER GUIDE

Praying for Singapore: “More S’pore Residents Have No Religion in 2025 Than in 2020”

» **Sovereign Awakening for the Unaffiliated:**

Pray for the 23.9% of our population who have no religious affiliation. Ask the LORD to shatter the illusions of secular self-reliance, materialism, and intellectual pride that often blind hearts. Pray that the Holy Spirit will stir a deep, inescapable spiritual hunger among Singaporeans, convicting them of their sin and leading them to find true satisfaction and eternal rest in Christ alone.

» **Boldness and Clarity in Gospel Witness:**

Pray for our congregation as we live in an increasingly secular society. May God grant us the grace to stand firm on biblical truth without compromise, resisting the temptation to dilute the Gospel to fit a secular culture. Pray for daily, God-given opportunities to engage our non-religious neighbours, colleagues, and family members with clarity, humility, and theological conviction, proclaiming Christ crucified as the only answer to human brokenness.

» **Protecting and Discipling the Next Generation:**

Pray especially for youth and young adults, who represent the largest demographic turning toward secularism, with 26.8% of those aged 15–24 identifying as having no religion. Pray that Christian families and our church ministries will prioritise deep, robust biblical discipleship so that our young people will not merely inherit a cultural faith but be granted saving faith, building their lives securely upon the unshakable foundation of God’s Word.
