MINISTRY UPDATES FOR PRAYER & SERVICE

Pastor Eric Tay & Goshen B-P Church

We were greatly encouraged last Sunday as Pastor Eric Tay shared his heart's burden for the planting of Goshen B-P Church. As Pastor Eric shared, the Lord had placed this vision in his heart about fifteen years ago, and he is now ready to take this burden forward.

As our Church Session listened to and prayed with Pastor Eric over the past year, we were led to partner with him in this church plant as fellow labourers in the Gospel. While this is not a Zion Serangoon church plant, we recognise the role God has given us in supporting Pastor Eric through prayer, as well as practical and financial assistance. It is also Pastor Eric's desire for Goshen B-P Church to join the Bible-Presbyterian Church in Singapore (BPCIS) once the church has been officially registered.

If you feel led to serve alongside Pastor Eric, as some of you already have, please let him know. Do also introduce your Chinese-speaking, non-believing friends, colleagues, and family members to Pastor Eric so that opportunities to share the Gospel may arise. Please continue to uphold this new church and Gospel ministry in prayer.

Each year, we have the wonderful opportunity to organise and host our Community Carnival. Over the years, the Lord has brought many people to these outreach events. Through each Carnival, we have had many opportunities to build friendships with our guests and, more importantly, to share the Gospel with them.

God willing, the Lord will bring many children so that our AWANA ministry may be revitalised and strengthened. This is something we can all pray for as we prepare for the 2026 Community Carnival.

ZS70 Celebrations

As announced during ACM 2026 in April, our church will be celebrating ZS70 in a significant way. Throughout the year, we will hold various ministries and events to celebrate the Lord's faithful care and steadfast love towards Zion Serangoon over the past 70 years. To recap, here are some of the key ministries and outreaches planned for 2027:

- Covenant Family Conferences (January–March) — building strong marriages and Christ-centred families.
- Community service projects (January–December) — serving the poor and marginalised in Serangoon and beyond.
- ZS70 Church Camp (June) — Kuala Lumpur.

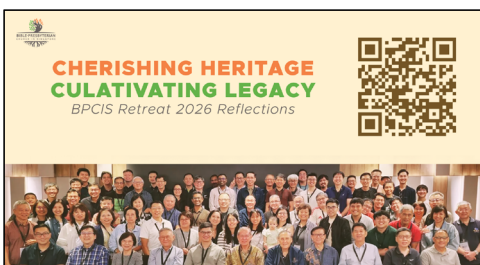
