WEEKLY PRAYER GUIDE

Commemoration of 2nd Morning Service (2MS) 10th Anniversary

The Nepal Tragedy, ZS Church Camp and ZS MEM

What do these 3 events have in common?

Brothers and sisters, in the past week, when did you spare a moment to pray or think about Nepal? Probably none of us were there or anywhere near the floods when they happened. For those of us at the Church Camp, what did you take away with you? Finally, for the one hundred or so people who came to Mission Emphasis Month, how have you been able to apply any of these 6 ways as a Gardener living missionally?

If I were to venture a guess, a common factor could be that these events and related reflections and thoughts have gone to 'sit' at the back of our minds. In the face of many new situations and events filling our hours and days, that is simply the nature of being human, right?

But as believers and followers of our Redeemer God, could we be 'more than human'? After all, we are filled with God the Holy Spirit, whose power and presence enable us to live with purpose and direction that God has set out in Scripture, that the earth "will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD as the waters cover the sea" (Habakkuk 2:14, ESV). But how? To see the whole world acknowledge and bow at the name of Jesus (Philippians 2:9-11) is a glorious vision that turns into reality as each of us becomes missional, one step at a time.

So, even if you have forgotten (and that's okay), here again are the 6 steps:

Learn *"Teach me to do your will, for you are my God!"
Psalm 143:10a*

Welcome *"When a stranger sojourns with you in your land, you shall not do him wrong. You shall treat the stranger who sojourns with you as the native among you, and you shall love him as yourself, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt: I am the Lord your God." Leviticus 19:33-34*

- Pray** *“pray without ceasing,” 1 Thessalonians 5:17*
- Mobilise** *“Therefore encourage one another and build one another up, just as you are doing”. 1 Thessalonians 5:11*
- Send** *“And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, “How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!” Romans 10:15*
- Go** *“But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.” Acts 1:8*

So here you are – 6 ways to live missionally.

The first 5 ways can happen readily here in Singapore. As for Go, a short-term team is heading to Cambodia from 16 to 23 Nov – pray for them. A few of us work in Christian and mission organisations in Singapore, stirring many to reach out to the nations; they may not have crossed Singapore’s geographical borders, but are “Go-ing” too!

Finally, over the next few months, the Foreign Missions Committee will share more so that God’s global mission may be better known and inspire all of God’s Gardeners at Serangoon Gardens and beyond. Watch this space and pray for us too!
